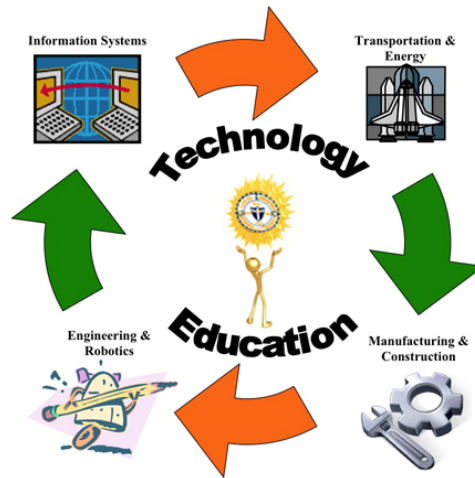


# Industrial & Technology Education Roundtable
